



Event Specifics

Event Setup and Teardown: Setup typically begins on Tuesday morning for an event that runs Friday, Saturday and Sunday with teardown being completed Monday.

Insurance: As per state law, the carnival operators carry a minimum \$1,000,000 insurance policy. **They always hold the property owner, charity and festival harmless and add them as an additional insured to that policy.**

Fire Safety: The local fire department does an inspection of all the rides and cooking facilities before the event begins. Additionally, all rides are state inspected yearly.

Beer and Wine: No alcohol will be sold at the event unless agreed upon in advance.

Security: Provided as required by the property owner, festival or the host city. Most cities have a general policy with respect to carnival events.

Porta-Potty's: Restroom facilities are provided as required.

Trash: The carnival vendor is responsible for all trash cleanup and disposal, which they perform at least twice per day and again at the conclusion of the event.

Parking: All other parking areas of the location will be available during this event.

Fencing: Some portions of the carnival may be fenced for safety reasons or as required.

First Aid: The carnival typically employs first aid personnel and local fire/rescue will be called if necessary.

Event Layout: A detailed site plan will be provide after a location is agreed upon.

Music: No live music unless agreed upon in advance.

Food: Health Department permits are obtained as required.

Street Closures: We do not generally close any streets for a carnival operation in a parking lot.
